PARAMETERS

Requirements for Participation

- Must meet basic Trawick Foundation guidelines (see www.trawick.org)
- Must contribute to positive outcomes in school and life for Montgomery County youth
- Must incorporate a minimum of four partners, including one of the designated schools

- A nonprofit is eligible for only one 2017 team
- Existing TeamUp nonprofit grantees are eligible to join a 2017 team. However, a nonprofit may be a Lead Partner on only one team during their three year grant period.
- At least one nonprofit partner must have an operating budget of under \$1 million

- All partners must have attended the TeamUp 2017 briefing
- All partners must participate equally in the development and implementation of the project
- One partner must be the Lead Partner for the team
- Lead partner must have the capacity to be responsible for project administrative management and be the liaison with the Foundation
- Lead partner will receive grant funds to distribute for project costs including payment to partners according to a grant agreement with Trawick Foundation
- Any partner may contribute any of the following: project operations manager, site for the project, staff, supplies, etc. However, any material resource purchased with TeamUp funds, remain with the school for the project.
- Primary project staff of all nonprofit organization partners working with the youth must have completed or agree to participate in Montgomery County Collaboration Council's *Advancing Youth Development Training*.
